



QUILTS 2010 / Workshop facility information

Quilt Show pre-registered class participants at Lake Metroparks Farmpark

- * Classes are conducted in the exhibit hall “Workshop” room. The exception would be a class that would need access to sinks or easy clean up areas, such as fabric dyeing.
- * The “Workshop” is located in the Exhibit Hall of the Visitor Center. This area is designed in the corner of the room with wall partitions defining the interior space. Only class participants will be allowed in the workshop; however, public guests may be viewing quilts in the exhibit hall while workshops are held. School groups, scouts and tour groups may also be visiting the park. No quilts will be hung in the workshop so wall space is available for class participants.
- * Portable light – highly recommended! Fluorescent lighting above. Power strips are available for your extension cords for sewing machines and additional lighting brought in by the student.
- * Seat cushions for metal chairs helpful – optional and recommended. Chairs may be stacked for better height.
- * Irons and ironing boards provided. Bring a bottle of water if you want steam. Some irons are to be used as dry irons only.
- * Room temperature – if room is too cold or too hot, you need to ask the admissions staff to get the temperature adjusted. On those rare warm days when the room is heated up and won’t cool down, the emergency door may be opened.
- * Packed lunches from home may be eaten in the Exhibit Hall during lunch break. Beverages and snacks are also available in the Gift Shop.
- * Farmpark has cafeteria facilities for purchasing lunch. Hot and cold items are offered and generally cost a total of \$7.00 more or less. If you are attending a full day class, a 1-hour lunch break is built into your class time. Purchased lunches to be eaten in the café only.
- * Program participants are invited to tour the quilt show prior to or after class, as well as during your lunch break if time allows. Facility hours are 9am to 5pm.
- * Parking at Farmpark is free. Program Participants may unload their equipment at the flagpole circle and drop off in the lobby before parking your car in the parking lot. Doors open at 9am.
