

## **Ruche By Hand, Ruche By Machine & Ruche Historic – Mums, Pansies & Roses**

Learn to ruche perfectly and quickly on French wired ribbon that is easy to hold, easy to see and easy to hand gather with big stitches. The result will be a precise, showy flower that will hold its shape on a purse, wallhanging, quilt block or embroidery. Also watch Cindy demonstrate how to ruche a mum and a 3D pansy/rose on any sewing machine. Students are welcome to take turns ruching on the classroom machine. It is not necessary to bring a machine to class as most ruching will be done by hand. Also ruche exactly the way it was done on a circa 1850 Baltimore Album applique ruched Christmas Cactus quilt block that will be on display in class. Kit fee of \$10 is payable to the instructor in class. Kit includes instructions, French and silk ribbons, fabric, crinoline, needles and thread to create 3 different ruched mums, a pansy, a rose and leaves.

**Bring to class:** strong poly medium gray thread and other flower colors, also scissors, pins, measure, chalk mechanical pencil such as Bohin Mechanical or sharp chalk pencil, needle threader, thread wax, extra light and magnification. Bring if you have: \*chalk pounce white, \*The Ruching Edge, \*The Mini Ruching Edge. Starred items are available to use in class.
