WHAT WE DO

The general duties of a ranger are to provide public safety and natural resource management within our park system. Our work includes:

- Enforcing park rules and regulations, as well as state laws including criminal, traffic and fish/game laws.
- Enhancing visitor experience by ensuring safe and clean parks.
- Monitoring all park properties by patrol vehicle bike, ATV or on foot.

BASIC REQUIREMENTS

- 21 years of age
- High school diploma/GED
- Valid driver's license
- OPOTA certified
- Pass a background check
- Pass a physical fitness and medical examination prior to appointment

HOW CAN I BECOME A RANGER?

Requirements:

- If you would like to be a park ranger in the State of Ohio, you must have a current Ohio Peace Officer Certification. The State of Ohio has more than 60 police academies running continuously. For more information on attending an academy, download <u>this brochure</u>.
- Because the certification test is standardized, you can attend any Ohio police academy regardless of where in Ohio you hope to find employment.
- The police academy nearest to Lake Metroparks is located at <u>Lakeland Community</u> <u>College</u>.
- There is an academy at <u>Hocking College</u> in Nelsonville, Ohio geared toward natural resource law enforcement. This police academy is attended by many individuals who wish to become park rangers rather than municipal officers.
