

- 11. COORDINATE WORK TO ASSURE EFFICIENT AND ORDERLY SEQUENCES OF INSTALLATION OF CONSTRUCTION ELEMENTS, WITH PROVISIONS FOR ACCOMMODATING ITEMS INSTALLED LATER.
- 12. FOR PRODUCTS SPECIFIED BY ASSOCIATION OR TRADE STANDARDS, COMPLY WITH REQUIREMENTS OF THE STANDARD, EXCEPT WHEN MORE RIGID REQUIREMENTS ARE SPECIFIED OR ARE REQUIRED BY APPLICABLE CODES.

- 16. ALL REGULATORY PERMITS SHALL BE POSTED AT THE SITE INCLUDING OSHA REQUIRED POSTERS.
- 17. PROJECT FEATURES HAVE BEEN DESIGNED FOR
 OPERATIONAL, HYDROSTATIC, AND BACKFILL LOADS ON
 THE COMPLETED FEATURES. THE PROJECT FEATURES HAVE
 NOT BEEN DESIGNED TO RESIST THESE LOADS WHILE

WATER LEVELS

LAKE ERIE WATER LEVELS VARY CONSIDERABLY DUE TO LONG TERM AND SEASONAL DRAINAGE VARIATIONS IN THE GREAT LAKES BASIN AND SHORT-TERM STORM EVENTS.

THE WATER LEVELS SHOWN ON THE DRAWINGS ARE FOR VERTICAL REFERENCE ONLY AND ARE NOT INTENDED TO BE PREDICTIVE OF WATER LEVELS AT THE TIME OF CONSTRUCTION. THE DRAWINGS GENERALLY REFERENCE ORDINARY HIGH WATER (OHW) AT AN ELEVATION OF 573.4 FEET IGLD 1985.

PLEASE NOTE: RECENT LAKE ERIE WATER LEVELS HAVE BEEN CONSIDERABLY HIGHER THAN LONG TERM AVERAGES AND HAVE FREQUENTLY EXCEEDED THE ORDINARY HIGH-WATER MARK.

WATER LEVELS ARE TYPICALLY LOWEST IN DECEMBERJANUARY (JUST BEFORE LAKE ICE FORMS AND SLOWS
EVAPORATION) AND HIGHEST IN JUNE-AUGUST AND
FLUCTUATIONS ARE POSSIBLE FROM THE PREDICTED WATER
LEVELS. THE CONTRACTOR SHOULD BE AWARE OF THE
VARIABILITY OF LAKE ERIE WATER LEVELS AND PLAN FOR
POTENTIAL ADVERSE EFFECTS TO CONSTRUCTION
OPERATIONS. NO ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION WILL BE
PROVIDED FOR CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS IMPACTED BY
VARIABILITY OF WATER LEVELS.

ENVIRONMENTAL RESTRICTIONS

- 1. ANY SAND AND GRAVEL THAT WILL BE WITHIN THE FOOTPRINT OF THE PROPOSED REVETMENT AT THE PROJECT LOCATION MUST BE SIDECAST DOWNDRIFT BEFORE THE REVETMENT IS CONSTRUCTED.
- 2. THE MECHANICAL EQUIPMENT USED TO EXECUTE THE WORK SHALL BE OPERATED IN SUCH A WAY AS TO MINIMIZE TURBIDITY THAT COULD DEGRADE WATER QUALITY AND ADVERSELY AFFECT AQUATIC PLANT AND ANIMAL LIFE.

- 3. ALL CONSTRUCTION FILL MATERIAL SHALL MEET THE REQUIREMENTS AS SPECIFIED ELSEWHERE.
- 4. NO TREES GREATER THAN 3" DIAMETER BREAST HEIGHT (DBH) MAY BE CLEARED BETWEEN APRIL 1ST AND SEPTEMBER 30TH WITHOUT PRIOR AUTHORIZATION FROM THE OWNER.

GRANT REQUIREMENTS

COVENANT B OF THE JANUARY 27, 1972, EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY EXECUTIVE ORDER OF THE **GOVERNOR OF OHIO**

- 1. THE CONTRACTOR WILL NOT DISCRIMINATE AGAINST ANY EMPLOYEE OR APPLICANT FOR EMPLOYMENT BECAUSE OF RACE, COLOR, RELIGION, NATIONAL ORIGIN, ANCESTRY, OR SEX. SUCH ACTION SHALL INCLUDE, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, THE FOLLOWING: EMPLOYMENT, UPGRADING, DEMOTION, OR TRANSFER; RECRUITMENT OR RECRUITMENT ADVERTISING; LAY-OFF OR TERMINATION; RATES OF PAY OR OTHER FORMS OF COMPENSATION; AND SELECTION FOR TRAINING, INCLUDING APPRENTICESHIPS. THE CONTRACTOR AGREES TO POST IN CONSPICUOUS PLACES. AVAILABLE TO EMPLOYEES AND APPLICANTS FOR EMPLOYMENT, NOTICES TO BE PROVIDED, SETTING FORTH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS NONDISCRIMINATION CLAUSE.
- 2. THE CONTRACTOR WILL IN ALL SOLICITATIONS OR ADVERTISEMENTS FOR EMPLOYEES PLACED BY OR ON BEHALF OF THE CONTRACTOR, STATE THAT ALL QUALIFIED APPLICANTS WILL RECEIVE CONSIDERATION FOR EMPLOYMENT WITHOUT REGARD TO RACE, COLOR, RELIGION, NATIONAL ORIGIN, ANCESTRY, OR SEX.
- 3. THE CONTRACTOR WILL SEND TO EACH LABOR UNION OR REPRESENTATIVE OF WORKERS WITH WHICH HE HAS A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT OR OTHER CONTRACT OR UNDERSTANDING, A NOTICE TO BE PROVIDED BY THE STATE ADMINISTERING AGENCY, ADVISING THE SAID LABOR UNION OR WORKERS' REPRESENTATIVES OF THE CONTRACTOR'S COMMITMENTS UNDER THIS COVENANT AND SHALL POST COPIES OF THE NOTICE IN CONSPICUOUS PLACES AVAILABLE TO EMPLOYEES AND APPLICANTS FOR EMPLOYMENT.
- 4. THE CONTRACTOR WILL COMPLY WITH ALL PROVISIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, DIVISION OF PUBLIC WORKS (DPW) REGULATION ON EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY (EEO) AND WITH THE IMPLEMENTING RULES, REGULATIONS, AND APPLICABLE ORDERS OF THE STATE EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY COORDINATOR.
- 5. THE CONTRACTOR AGREES HE WILL FULLY COOPERATE WITH THE STATE ADMINISTERING AGENCY, THE STATE EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY COORDINATOR, AND WITH ANY OTHER OFFICIAL OR AGENCY OF THE STATE OR FEDERAL GOVERNMENT THAT SEEKS TO ELIMINATE UNLAWFUL EMPLOYMENT DISCRIMINATION, AND WITH ALL OTHER STATE AND FEDERAL EFFORTS TO ASSURE EQUAL EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES UNDER THIS CONTRACT. SAID CONTRACTOR SHALL COMPLY PROMPTLY WITH ALL REQUESTS AND DIRECTIONS FROM THE STATE ADMINISTERING AGENCY, THE STATE EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY COORDINATOR, AND ANY OF THE STATE OF OHIO'S OFFICIALS AND AGENCIES IN THIS REGARD, BOTH BEFORE AND DURING CONSTRUCTION.
- 6. FULL COOPERATION AS EXPRESSED IN CLAUSE 5 ABOVE, SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LISTED TO, BEING A WITNESS AND PERMITTING EMPLOYEES TO BE WITNESSES AND COMPLAINANTS IN ANY PROCEEDING INVOLVING QUESTIONS OR UNLAWFUL EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES, FURNISHING ALL INFORMATION AND REPORTS REQUIRED BY THE DPW REGULATION ON EEO AND BY THE RULES, REGULATIONS, AND ORDERS OF THE STATE EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY COORDINATOR PURSUANT

- THERETO, AND PERMITTING ACCESS TO HIS BOOKS, RECORDS, AND ACCOUNTS BY THE STATE ADMINISTERING AGENCY AND THE STATE EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY COORDINATOR FOR PURPOSES OF INVESTIGATION TO ASCERTAIN COMPLIANCE WITH SUCH RULES, REGULATIONS, AND ORDERS.
- 7. IN THE EVENT OF THE CONTRACTOR'S NONCOMPLIANCE WITH THE NONDISCRIMINATION CLAUSES OF THIS CONTRACT OR WITH ANY OF THE SAID RULES, REGULATIONS, OR ORDERS, THIS CONTRACT MAY BE CANCELED, TERMINATED, OR SUSPENDED IN WHOLE OR IN PART AND THE CONTRACTOR MAY BE DECLARED INELIGIBLE FOR FURTHER STATE CONTRACTS OR STATE ASSISTED CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH PROCEDURES AUTHORIZED IN THE DPW REGULATIONS ON EEO, AND SUCH OTHER SANCTIONS MAY BE INSTITUTED AND REMEDIES INVOKED AS PROVIDED IN SAID REGULATION OR BY RULE, REGULATION, OR ORDER OF THE STATE EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY COORDINATOR, OR AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY LAW.
- IN THE EVENT THIS CONTRACT IS TERMINATED FOR A MATERIAL BREACH OF SAID REGULATIONS, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BECOME LIABLE FOR ANY AND ALL DAMAGES AS A RESULT OF SAID BREACH.
- 8. THE CONTRACTOR WILL INCLUDE THE PORTION OF THE SENTENCE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING PARAGRAPH 1 AND THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPHS 1 THROUGH 8 IN EVERY SUBCONTRACT OR PURCHASE ORDER UNLESS EXEMPTED BY RULES, REGULATIONS, OR ORDERS OF THE STATE EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY COORDINATOR ISSUED PURSUANT TO SECTION 204 OF THE DPW REGULATION ON EEO, SO THAT SUCH PROVISIONS WILL BE BINDING UPON EACH SUBCONTRACTOR OR VENDOR. THE CONTRACTOR WILL TAKE SUCH ACTION WITH RESPECT TO ANY SUBCONTRACT OR PURCHASE ORDER AS THE STATE ADMINISTERING AGENCY MAY DIRECT AS A MEANS OF ENFORCING SUCH PROVISIONS, INCLUDING SANCTIONS FOR NONCOMPLIANCE: PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT IN THE EVENT THE CONTRACTOR BECOMES INVOLVED IN, OR IS THREATENED WITH LITIGATION WITH A SUBCONTRACTOR, VENDOR OR OTHER PARTY AS A RESULT OF SUCH DIRECTION BY THE STATE ADMINISTERING AGENCY, THE CONTRACTOR MAY REQUEST THE STATE OF OHIO TO ENTER INTO SUCH LITIGATION TO PROTECT THE INTERESTS OF THE STATE.


CLEAN AIR ACT AND FEDERAL WATER POLLUTION CONTROL ACT

- B. THAT ANY FACILITY TO BE UTILIZED IN THE ACCOMPLISHMENT OF THIS CONTRACT BECOMES LISTED ON THE EPA LIST, THIS CONTRACT MAY BE CANCELED, TERMINATED OR SUSPENDED IN WHOLE OR IN PART;

- C. THAT IN THE EVENT A FACILITY UTILIZED IN THE ACCOMPLISHMENT OF THIS CONTRACT BECOMES LISTED ON THE EPA LIST, THIS CONTRACT MAY BE CANCELED,
- D. THAT IT WILL COMPLY WITH ALL THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 114 OF THE AIR ACT AND SECTION 308 OF THE WATER ACT RELATING TO INSPECTION, MONITORING, ENTRY, REPORTS, AND INFORMATION, AS WELL AS ALL OTHER REQUIREMENTS SPECIFIED IN SECTION 114 AND SECTION 308, RESPECTIVELY, AND ALL REGULATIONS AND
- E. THAT IT WILL PROMPTLY NOTIFY THE GOVERNMENT OF THE RECEIPT OF ANY NOTICE FROM THE DIRECTOR, OFFICE OF FEDERAL ACTIVITIES, ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY, INDICATING THAT ANY FACILITY UTILIZED OR TO BE UTILIZED IN THE ACCOMPLISHMENT OF THIS CONTRACT IS UNDER CONSIDERATION FOR LISTING ON THE EPA LIST OF VIOLATING FACILITIES;
- F. THAT IT WILL INCLUDE THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPHS "A" THROUGH "G" IN EVERY SUBCONTRACT OR PURCHASE ORDER ENTERED INTO FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACCOMPLISHING THIS CONTRACT, UNLESS OTHERWISE EXEMPTED PURSUANT TO THE EPA REGULATIONS IMPLEMENTING THE AIR OR WATER ACT (40 CFR, PART 15.5), SO THAT SUCH PROVISIONS WILL BE BINDING UPON EACH SUBCONTRACTOR OR VENDOR;
- G. THAT IN THE EVENT THAT THE CONTRACTOR OR THE SUBCONTRACTORS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, SUPPLY AND SERVICE CONTRACTS ENTERED INTO FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACCOMPLISHING THIS CONTRACT WERE EXEMPTED FROM COMPLYING WITH THE ABOVE REQUIREMENTS UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF 40 CFR, PART 15.5(A), THE EXEMPTION SHALL BE NULLIFIED SHOULD THE FACILITY GIVE RISE TO A CRIMINAL CONVICTION (SEE 40 CFR, PART 15.20) DURING THE ACCOMPLISHMENT OF THIS CONTRACT. FURTHERMORE, WITH THE NULLIFICATION OF THE EXEMPTION, THE ABOVE REQUIREMENTS SHALL BE EFFECTIVE. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE GOVERNMENT, AS SOON AS THE CONTRACTOR'S OR THE SUBCONTRACTORS' FACILITY IS LISTED FOR HAVING GIVEN RISE TO A CRIMINAL CONVICTION NOTED IN 40
