1. Resolution 2024-015, Clean Ohio Grant Application

Mr. Palagyi explained Resolution 2024-014, Clean Ohio Grant Application. Mr. Palagyi explained that this resolution will authorize the Executive Director to submit a Clean Ohio Green Space Conservation Fund Grant Application for the Grand River Gorge Corridor Preservation Project Phase III. Mr. Palagyi said this is an outstanding property and the final cost of the property will be approximately \$1 million, but he expects to apply to Clean Ohio for approximately half of the cost.

2. Resolution 2024-016, West Creek Purchase Agreement

Mr. Palagyi said this Resolution would allow the Executive Director to enter into a Property Sale and Purchase Agreement with West Creek Conservancy for the purchase of approximately 95 acres in Painesville Township for an amount not to exceed the appraised value plus associated closing and professional service costs. Mr. Palagyi said this purchase will be contingent upon a successful grant that will be announced in late October.
